

Appendix 2

The tree species mentioned below was covered by the list of CITES by June 30 2003. Examples of commonly used commercial names are stated - these examples are not exhaustive. The safest way to control the CITES species is by entry via the Latin name, *in italics*. The list is only intended as a guide. For further information on commercial names for tropical tree species, see Appendix 1.

In addition it is noted that the lists of endangered species of fauna and flora are being revised from time to time and furthermore that specific resolutions are currently made, primarily within the framework of the EU, on individual species on the CITES list. The list below is not necessarily exhaustive. Information on these matters is available by addressing the Danish Forest and Nature Agency, which is also able to render more detailed information on the current regulations on specific species of flora and fauna. - c) cut flowers of artificially propagated plants.
- d) chemical derivatives and finished pharmaceutical products.

#5 Designates logs, sawn wood and veneer sheets.

#6 Designates logs, sawn wood, veneer sheets and plywood.

#7 Designates logs, wood-chips and unprocessed broken material.
